**Only the bees with lines visit feeder number two.**

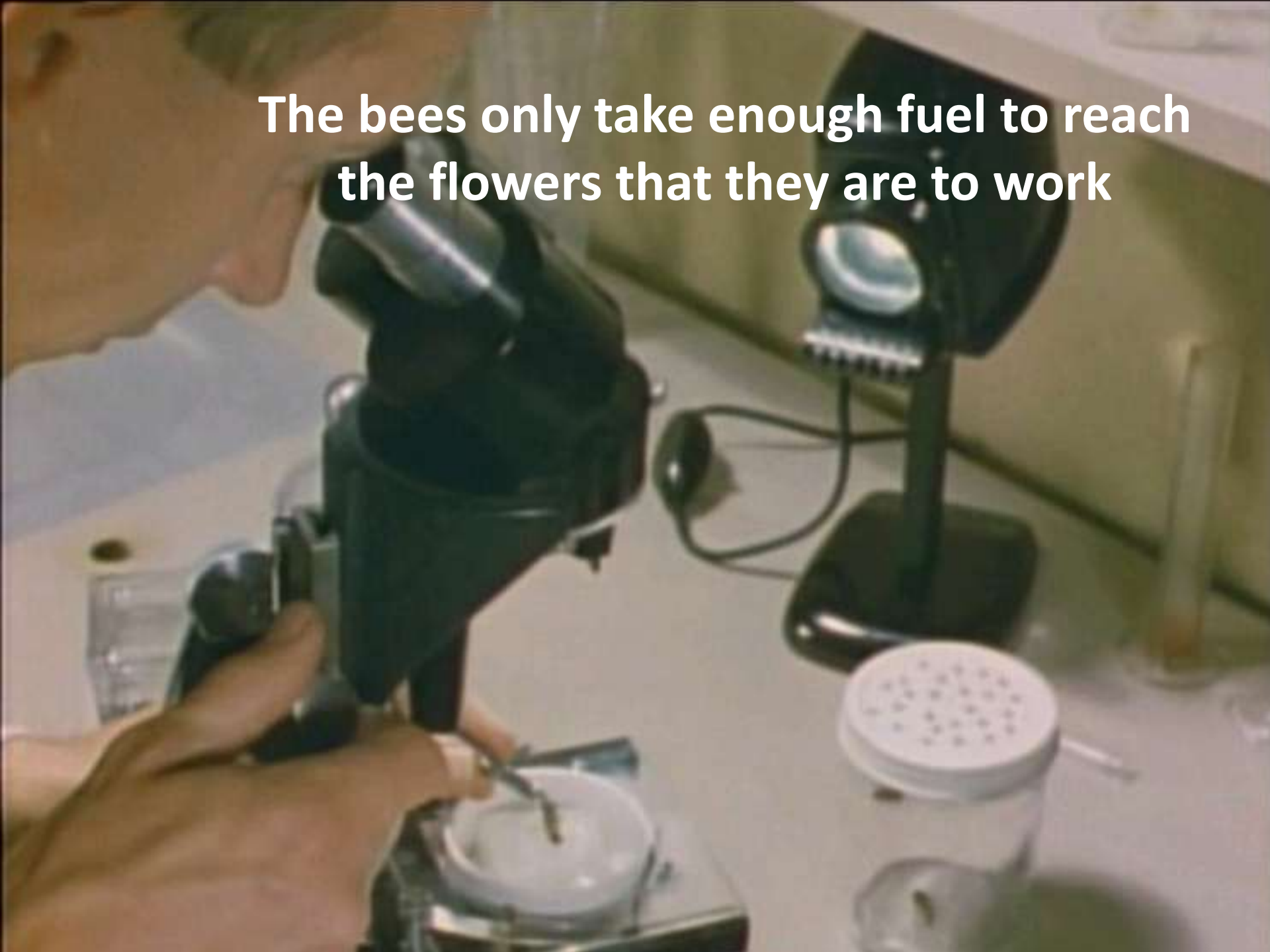

**The bees only take enough fuel to reach the flowers that they are to work**






**Prov 3:5 (ESV)**
