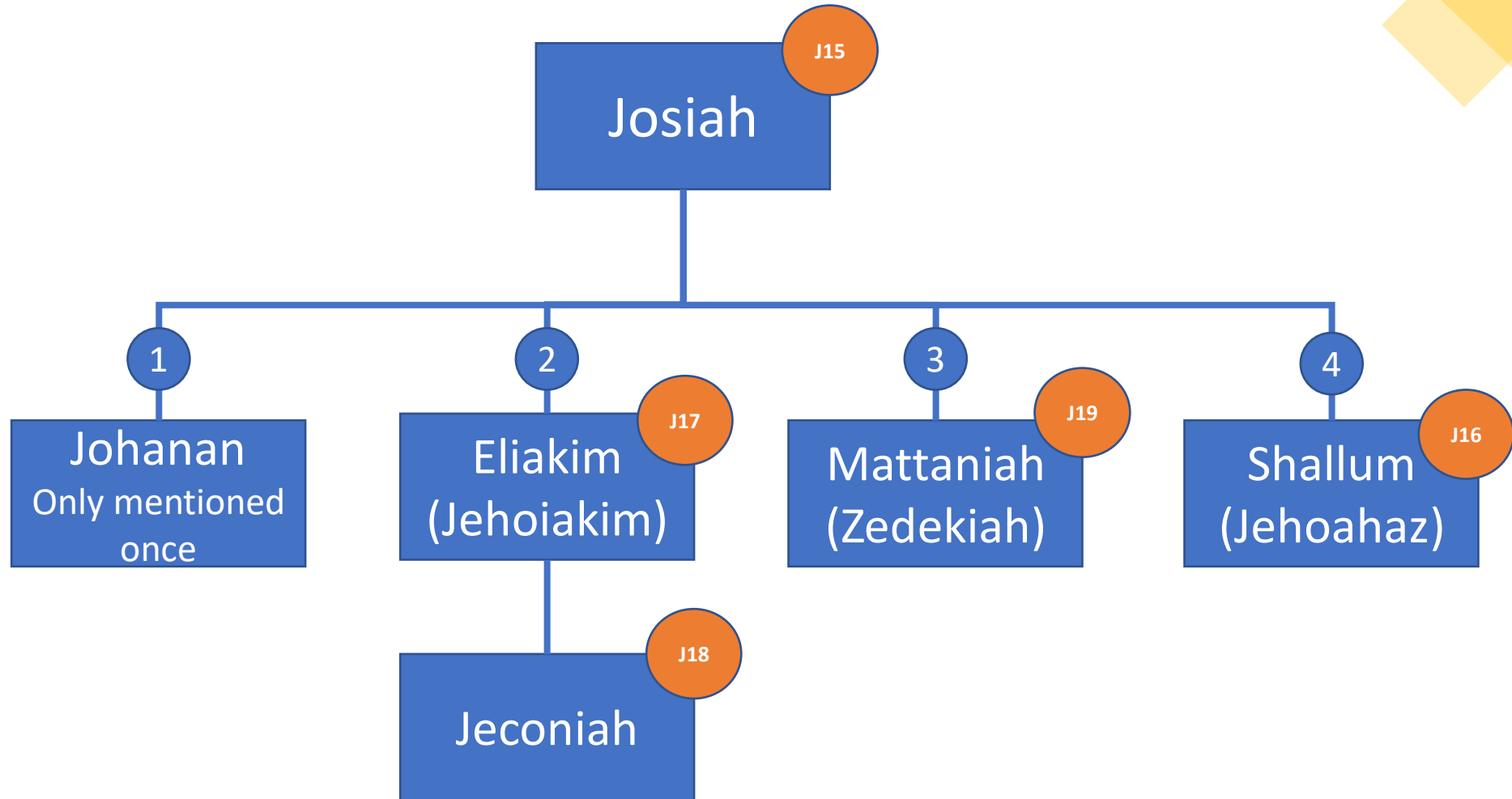


<b>DANIEL</b>	<b>GOD IS MY JUDGE</b>
<b>HANANIAH</b>	<b>JEHOVAH IS GRACIOUS</b>
<b>MISHAEL</b>	<b>WHO IS EQUAL TO GOD</b>
<b>AZARIAH</b>	<b>GOD IS A HELPER</b>

<b>NAME</b>	<b>BABYLONIAN MEANING</b>
<b>BELTESHAZZAR (CHIEF GOD) [DANIEL]</b>	HE WAS CALLED BELTESHAZZAR, DERIVED FROM BEL – THE CHIEF GOD.
<b>SHADRACH (SUN GOD) [HANANIAH]</b>	DENOTES THE SAME THING IN AN IDOLATROUS SENSE-- “THE FAVOUR, OR ILLUMINATION, OR INSPIRATION, OF THE SUN-GOD.”
<b>MESHACH (EARTH GOD) [MISHAEL]</b>	THE SUBSTITUTED NAME RETAINS A PART OF THE WORD, DISPLACING THE LAST SYLLABLE, WHICH IS THE NAME OF JEHOVAH, BY THE NAME “SHAK,” THE CHIEF GODDESS OF BABYLON, THE GODDESS OF BEAUTY AND PLEASURE.
<b>ABED-NEGO (FIRE GOD) [AZARIAH]</b>	“SERVANT OF THE SHINING LIGHT,” OR “SERVANT OF LUCIFER.”
